

Application Checklist

This checklist is for applying to a program at San Ignacio University Graduate School.

- 1. Candidates for admission to a graduate program are required to hold a bachelor's degree (or equivalent), from an accredited institution.
- 2. and master's degree for a Doctorate program from an accredited institution.
- 3. Prospective students are not required to submit Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or Miller Analogy Test (MAT) scores to support their application.
- 4. Submit test score reports for English Proficiency (if applicable). *Scores may not be more than two years old. Student taking classes in Spanish are exempt from taking this.*
- 5. Submit official transcripts (from all universities and colleges attended, for all degrees. Transcripts not in English are to be evaluated by an appropriate third party and translated into English.
- 6. Submit written statements
- 7. Submit 3 Letters of Recommendation
- 8. Submit Professional resume or curriculum vita CV.
- 9. A minimum 3.00 grade-point average
- 10. Government issued picture identification (upon request)
- 11. Submit the application and pay the fee.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOCTORAL ADMISSION

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY (STUDENTS TAKING COURSES IN SPANISH ARE EXEMPT)

Applicants whose native language is not English and who have not earned a degree from an appropriately accredited institution where English is the principal language of instruction are required to provide proof of English Proficiency as part of their application.

A minimum score of 65 on the paper-delivered Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL PBT), or 80 on the Internet Based Test (iBT); 6.5 on the International English Language Test (IELTS); 58 on the Pearson Test of English Academic Score Report; 105 on the Duolingo English Test; or 55 on the 4-skill Michigan English Test (MET), or 650/LP on the Michigan Examination for the Certificate of Competency in English (ECCE), or 650/LP on the Michigan Examination for the Certificate of Proficiency in English (ECPE).

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

Submit official copies of transcripts where a degree was earned. All transcripts must be enclosed in letterhead envelopes from the issuing institution(s). Do not open the transcript envelope as this will invalidate the official status of the transcript. Transcripts not in English are to be evaluated by an appropriate third party and translated into English.

PROFESSIONAL RESUME

Doctoral applicants must submit a professional resume or curriculum vita (CV). Applicants will be notified for an Interview

APPLICATION SHOULD ALSO INCLUDE LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Applicants must obtain three letters of recommendation. Two of the letters should be completed by people who can attest to the applicant's capacity to complete rigorous graduate studies, and one by a person supervising the applicant's professional work.

ADMISSION POLICY

Procedures and requirements are specific to each program. Admission to study in one program does not ensure admission to all programs. The decision to deny admission cannot be appealed. It is your responsibility to be aware of the policies and requirements. San Ignacio University Graduate School reserves the right to change any provision or requirement, including fees, at any time, with or without notice.
